UNIT: I ACTION TAKEN REPORT

01/26 BoG_Mar-2021

Presentation and action taken report by the Director, IST,JNTUH after 25th BoG Meeting dated 19th December, 2020.

Director, Institute of Science and Technology is very happy to inform that another 10% additional grant is received from NPIU to Institute of Science and Technology, JNTUH. Allocation was under various head is 60:30:10% ie.,Rs.42:21:07 (in Lakhs) in Procurement, Academic Process, IOC respectively. The utilization under various heads was initiated as per the time line and the details are Annexed.

Director, Institute of Science and Technology, wish to submit that the 3rd phase of Performance audit during 15-17 February, 2021 was successfully completed. The audit report is yet to receive from NPIU.

Director will brief about the activities related to the institute in general and TEQIP-III activities in particular from last BoG. This will enable the honorable Chairman and members of BoG to provide suggestions and to take appropriate decisions.

The Action taken report is as follows:

The status of the items placed for consideration and approval in the 25th BoG meeting is presented item wise for information to the BoG members.

- ITEM No: 03/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG approved the total expenditure incurred since 24th BoG to 16th Dec, 2020.
- ITEM No: 04/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG approved enhancement of seed grant to 7 faculty for mini R&D projects and proceeding were given for further action.
- ITEM No: 05/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG approved one patent filing titled: "Design of pilot scale wetlands treatment system for feasibility studies and proposal of a design for individual household" and proceeding order is given for further action.
- ITEM No: 06/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG has approved the change of Principal Investigator for mini R&D project and order was issued.
- ITEM No: 07/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG approved 2 programs and we have conducted Indian National Groundwater Conference-2021"(INGWC-2021) and International Workshop on Environment and Energy(IWEE-2021).
- ITEM No:08/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG has not approved the renewal fee of 3 patents and it is intimated to the faculty.
- ITEM No: 09/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG approved to conduct the programs subject to the availability of funds & time. Only 3 programs were organized by the faculty of IST.
- ITEM No: 10/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG has approved subject to the availability of funds.
- ITEM No: 11/25 BoG_Dec-20: The BoG has approved the enhancement of Viva-Voce examination fee.

Procurement of Goods:

Out of the total allocated budget of Rs.427 lakhs (including 10% of the additional grant) towards purchase of equipment/ goods. 100% utilization is completed under the same head in the month of March, 2020 for the initial grant. For the remaining 10% of additional grant, procurement process is under progress and will be completed as per the timeline.

Academic Processes:

- As per the NPIU, PIP, Number of activities under academic processes were listed for execution of the TEQIP III project:
 - improvement in teaching, learning, and research competence, (faculty staff training, enhancing knowledge and research competence, management development training of faculty members, subject area training programs, training of technical staff)
 - ✓ Enhancement of research, development and innovation
 - ✓ Improving transition rates of all the students
 - ✓ Instituting academic and non-academic reforms
 - Student Employability: increasing interaction with industry, student career counseling placement.
 - ✓ Increasing faculty productivity and Motivation and Twinning activities.

- ❖ During 23rd BoG the budget for Academic Process under TEQIP-III was reallocated due to additional grant of Rs.28 lakhs towards academic activities. This includes contingency grant, patent fee, M.Tech project work and others.
- ❖ On 11th March, 2021, NPIU has released 10% additional grant i.e Rs.70 Lakhs as incentive to the best performing institutions. JNTUH IST is one among.
- Out of Rs.70 Lakhs, 30% of the grant is allocated for academic activities. This includes Research Assistantship, R&D (M.Tech Projects & Mini projects of faculty), FSD, Reforms and Governance (NBA fee) & Industry Institution Interaction (Expert lectures & Industrial Visits). Hence the total amount allocated under this head is Rs.329.00 Lakhs.
- ❖ Till date we have incurred an amount of Rs.3,07,19,403/- under various heads including 10% additional grant as tabulated below:
