#### MINUTES OF THE 26th BoG MEETING

The 26<sup>th</sup>BoG meeting of IST, JNTUH was convened through Video Conference mode from 02:30 pm, on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> March,2021.

In the opening remarks, Hon'ble Chairperson had conveyed greetings to all the members of the governing body. Chairperson and BoG members appreciated the institute for the incentive received from NPIU i.e 10% additional grant for successful implementation of TEQIP-III project as per the timelines. Chairperson reviewed the expenditure status, performance of the institute and other indicators.

Prof.G.Krishna Mohan, Director, IST, JNTUH extended a warm welcome to the Chairperson, Members of the BoG and Special Invitees. Director IST through presentation had briefed about the status of the TEQIP III project, performance auditing, significant activities taken up and achievements of IST to the honorable members of the BoG since last meeting i.e. Dec 2020 to March 2021.

Director has informed that JNTUH IST was recognized as one of the best performing institute for the successful implementation of TEQIP-III project and informed that NPIU has allocated 10 % of additional PLA as an incentive.
